

# SEPARATION AID FOR WASTE AND RECYCLABLES



## RESIDUAL WASTE

- baking paper
- cassettes, cigarette butts
- clothes and shoes that can no longer be worn, rags
- cat litter, litter for other small animals
- photos, slides
- toiletries, sanitary towels, diapers, tissues
- rubbish, filled vacuum cleaner bags
- wood ash, coal ash



## ORGANIC WASTE

- bread, cakes, moldy bread
- paper towels, kitchen roll
- food leftovers
- bones and fish bones
- organic garden waste
- egg packaging and eggshells
- tea and coffee filters

Please wrap any moist organic waste in sheets of (news)paper or put it into paper bags, thank you. Never use plastic bags, not even biodegradable ones.



## WASTE PAPER

- books without leather cover or plastic cover
- cardboard boxes, shredded, folded
- catalogues, brochures
- envelopes
- exercise books
- newspapers
- office waste paper, old documents
- paper packaging, e. g. flour or cookie packaging
- wrapping paper



## LIGHT PACKAGING

- aluminum, sheet metal and plastic lids, aluminum trays
- cartons for milk and beverages
- plastic bags from pasta, sweets, cookies
- plastic bottles for detergents and personal care products
- plastic cups for cottage cheese, pudding, yogurt
- instant soup packaging
- tin cans of preserved products like meat or vegetables

Please only dispose of completely empty light packaging and containers in the yellow bag!



## HAZARDOUS WASTE

- acids, methylated spirits
- antifreeze, wood preservatives, pesticides, rust inhibitor, pest control agent
- photo chemicals
- liquid paints and lacquers
- liquid tar paint
- nail polish, nail polish remover
- solvents, turpentine, benzene
- spray cans with residues



## BULKY WASTE

- bedroom furniture such as beds, bed frames, slatted frames, mattresses
- bookshelves, scratching posts, cat trees
- carpets, flooring, PVC floor coverings
- framed pictures, paintings
- furniture from bathroom, office, kitchen, living room and upholstered furniture
- sledges, skis, snowboards
- suitcases, travel bags

On request you can find out, what else is to be disposed of as bulky waste.

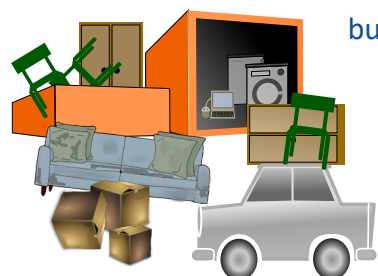
